**Preamble:**

As stated in the Extra-Curricular Handbook, participation in athletics is a privilege. Student-athletes earn the privilege to participate by adhering to high standards of personal conduct and ethical behavior. The essential elements of building ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and our PBIS behavioral expectations; Be Respectful, Be Responsible, and Be Proud.

Parents play a vital role in the development of student athletes. It is the duty of all concerned and involved with the Peacock Middle School program to exemplify the highest ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and fair play. All parties are expected to abide by the guidelines for behavior described in the Extra-Curricular Handbook and the following code of ethics.

**Athlete's Code:**

1. I will place academic achievement as my highest priority.
